

# Step 3: Create a Send Connector Exchange 2010

1. Open the **Send Connector** tab under **Server Management > Hub Transport** option
  2. Right-click in the empty space and select **New Send Connector**
  3. Ensure intended use field is set to **custom**.
  4. Enter **Vautastic** in **Name** field, then click **Next**
  5. Click **Add** in the **address space** window
  6. In the **address** field, enter **{domainprefix}.vaultastic.com**
  7. Select **Route mail through the following smart hosts**. Click **Add..**
  8. Select **FQDN**. Enter **o365-v4.vaultastic.com**. Click **OK**, then **Next**.
  9. Leave **smart host authentication** settings as **None**. Click **Next**.
  0. Choose the **Hub Transport Server's that apply**. Click **Next**.
  1. Preview **Configuration Summary**. On the **New Connector** page, review the configuration summary for the connector.  
  
If you want to modify the settings, click **Back**.  
  
To create the Send connector by using the settings in the configuration summary, click **New**.
  2. On the **Completion** page, review the following, and then click **Finish** to close the wizard:
    - A status Completed indicates that the wizard completed the task successfully.
    - A status Failed indicates that the task wasn't completed successfully. If the task fails, review the summary for an explanation, and then click Back to make any configuration changes.
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
