Preparation

Import MAILDIR to Vaultastic4

- After uploading the data files to S3, the next step in the process is to migrate the data into **Vaultastic4** accounts using the LegacyFlo application.
- For each **MAILDIR** file submit a separate request.
- To submit multiple requests, manually create and upload a CSV. Use the help given in the following sections to define your requests.
- When [submitting a request](https://docs.mithi.com/home/how-to-submit-a-data-migration-request-in-the-legacyflo-application) (<https://docs.mithi.com/home/how-to-submit-a-data-migration-request-in-the-legacyflo-application>) to upload MAILDIR data, select **MAILDIR-VAULTASTIC4** as the **Request type**.
- Provide **MAILDIR file details under the Source information** section.
- Provide **Vaultastic4 server details under the Destination information** section.
- Refer to the following screenshot and table to understand the description and sample values for the fields.

Source Information (MAILDIR Files)

FIELD NAME	DESCRIPTION
S3 Bucket Name	<p>The S3 bucket that has the source file to be processed. Select the S3 bucket name from the drop-down list.</p> <p>The list will show</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• S3 buckets in your AWS account registered with LegacyFlo• the bucket hosting your Vaultastic Open Store(mithi-ind1-vaultastic-legacystore).

FIELD NAME	DESCRIPTION
S3 Folder path	<p>If the file is on the Vaultastic Open Store, then this parameter will have the name of your Vaultastic domain. Example: baya-com.vaultastic.com</p> <p>If the file is on your own bucket, give the folder which contains the file. Leave this value empty if the source file is on the root of the S3 bucket.</p> <p>NOTE: S3 folder path should not start or end with a "/"</p>
File name	<p>The source filename. The compressed file such as .zip or .pst which contains the source data</p> <p>NOTE: Filenames should not start or end with a "/"</p>

Destination Information (Vaultastic4)

FIELD NAME	DESCRIPTION	SAMPLE VALUE (TO UPLOAD TO VAULTASTIC4)
User ID	The user id on the destination Vaultastic 4 server. (Note: The id should not contain the domain name.)	"john.smith" (To upload data to john.smith@baya-com.vaultastic.com)
Domain	Destination domain on Vaultastic 4	"baya-com.vaultastic.com"
Password	Password of the user on Vaultastic 4	<p>Note: Passwords cannot contain special characters mentioned in the list given here (https://docs.mithi.com/home/faqs-about-migrating-email-data-using-imap-in-the-legacyflo-application#which-special-characters-are-allowed-in-the-source-or-destination-user-password-). Update the password before submitting the request.</p>
Server	Hostname for the domain on Vaultastic 4	"baya-com.vaultastic.com"
