New Features

Tighter Security with Granular ediscovery controls

Earlier versions of Vaultastic provided limited and combined controls over access to the mailing and download capabilities of the eDiscovery application.

Vaultastic 4.5.1 has made these options granular to give you more control over access to the ediscovery application.

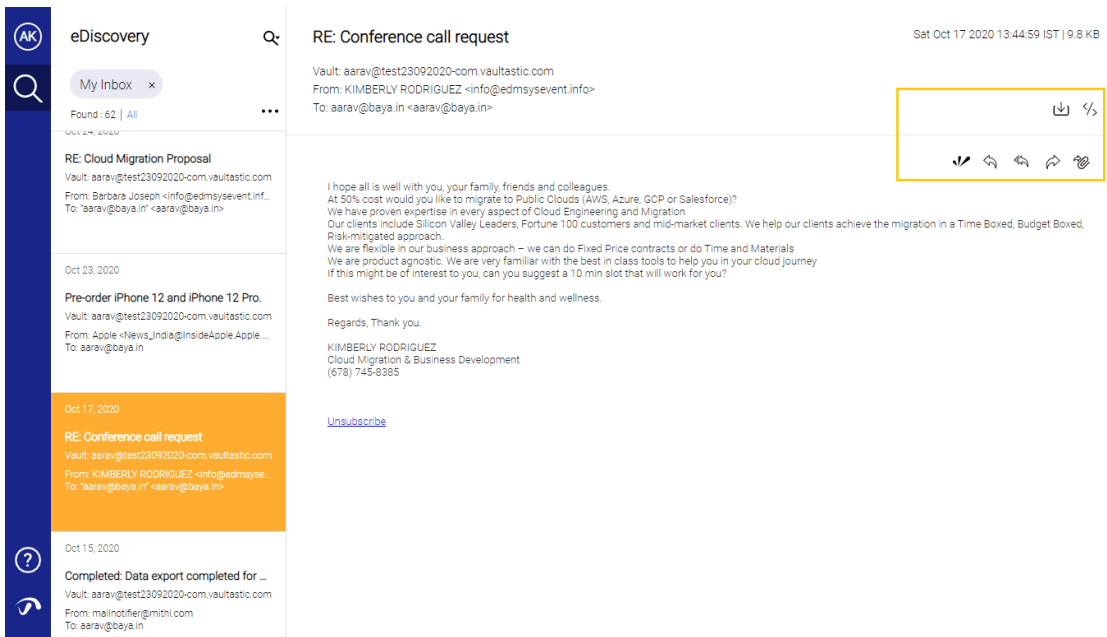

These granular security controls give you greater flexibility when assigning role-based access to the ediscovery application - self-service or complete (auditor) access.



Some of the prevalent use of these controls are listed below:

- **Self Service:** When end-users are given self-service access into Vaultastic to search for their older mail, you can only allow "view and restore" rights or "view, restore and download" rights.
- **Team supervision:** Managers often need to oversee the team's communication and share knowledge with other team members. You can give managers full access to a limited set of vaults with "forwarding" rights and "Upload to Ideolve" rights to help them share and collaborate on the search results.
- **Audits:** Auditors typically have access to the vaults of all or selected sets of users. You can give auditors the "Upload to Ideolve" rights to help them share and collaborate on the search results.
