Copy, Move or delete files from S3 buckets

Overview

Using the request types in the S3 category, you can manage your S3 buckets. These requests can also be used to manage your Vaultastic Open & Deep Stores.

- To copy files from one S3 bucket to another, you can use the S32S3-Copy request type.
- To move files from one S3 bucket to another, you can use the S32S3-Move request type
- To delete files from a S3 bucket, you can use the S3-DELETE request type.

The source and destination buckets can be in different accounts and regions.

Before submitting any of the requests, the source and destination buckets have to be registered with LegacyFlo as mentioned here. (https://docs.mithi.com/home/preparation-of-s3-bucket-for-legacyflo)

S32S3-Copy	Use this request type to copy files from one S3 bucket to another . Post the operation, the selected files will be available on the source and the destination buckets. S32S3-Move	Use this request type to move files from one S3 bucket to another . Post the operation, the selected files will be available on the destination buckets.
