


Google Chat Api configuration

To enable the archival of Google Chat transcripts, you have to Configure the Google Chat API as given in the steps below

d: Select the CONFIGURATION tab





e: Add the App name - Chat API quickstart app

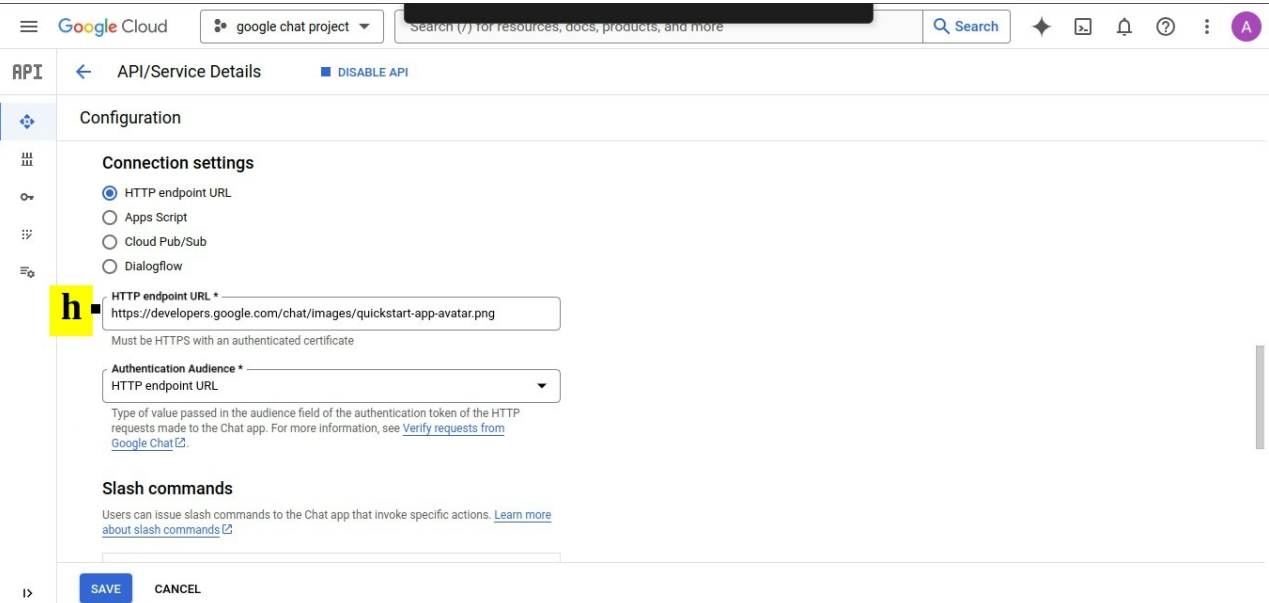
f: Add the Avatar URL - <https://developers.google.com/chat/images/quickstart-app-avatar.png>
